

# Sant Nischal Singh Ji

Sant Nischal Singh ji was born on **18th April 1882** at Mitha Tiwana (Pakistan). With the blessings of his master Mahant Jawahar Singh Ji (of *Mitha Tiwana, Pakistan*) he had his education as a Sanskrit Scholar at Vidya peeth Haridwar and Varanasi. He became well versed in the Sanskrit Granthas and mastered the Sikh Scriptures. He became a learned Sikh saint scholar who with a deep knowledge of other religions as well. Because of this he came to be known as Pandit Sant Nischal Singh Ji. Sant Nischal Singh Ji was a rare and probably the first example in Sikh history having virtues of Pandit and Sant together in one personality.



He had saintly virtues and inclination from an early age.

He dedicated his life to service of mankind. He preached love for education especially among women and down trodden sections of society spreading the message of spirituality Sewa and Simran.

He established nearly 53 school and colleges in different parts of India. He founded the Guru Nanak Senior Secondary School, Guru Nanak Girls Senior Secondary School, Guru Nanak Girls College in Yamuna Nagar Haryana.

He passed on on **23rd August 1978**.

In 1953 Pandit Sant Nischal Singh Ji also established the Dera Sant Pura in Yamuna Nagar in memory of martyrs who laid down their lives during partition of Punjab in 1947 at Dera Sant Pura Mandi Bahauddin District Gujrat (Pakistan).

Sant Nischal Singh Gurmat Sangeet Academy is providing training to about 45 children in Classical Gurmat Sangeet and Kirtan. Besides giving them basic education of English Hindi and Punjabi these children are getting training in Shudh Gurubani Path and katha Santhya in the daily religious activities of the Dera.
